OPEN POSITIONS:

1 Mayoral Position | 2 City Council seats
4-Year Terms | Jan 1, 2018 - Dec 31, 2021

REQUIREMENTS:

18 years old | U.S. Citizen | Registered Voter
Resident of Vineyard for 12 consecutive months prior to the General Election

Please be aware that any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to vote or hold elective office is restored as provided by statute.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

- Interested parties may declare candidacy Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. between June 1 and June 7 at the Vineyard City Recorder's Office.
- If more than two candidates file for each position, a primary election will be held on Tuesday, August 15, 2017. The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2017.

Will Teach for Food

The first school district in the Vineyard area came in about 1883. Called the Provo Bench School District No. 18, it had a total budget of \$780. Rather than receiving a paycheck, teachers were paid in potatoes, flour, lumber or other goods. Students were taught and orally tested on practical skills, such as shoeing horses and planting crops.
