## Vineyard Heritage Commission Corner

### *Now, That's Good Fishing!*

The number of fish in Utah Lake in the mid-1800s was legendary. Unfettered by dams and having access to an unpolluted lake, the fish were easily caught as they spawned. Fishing poles were seldom used; rather they used long poles with large three-pronged hooks or even their hands. "I was at Utah Lake...I saw thousands [of fish] caught by hand...they simply put their hand into the stream, and threw them out as fast as they could pick them up." (Parley P. Pratt, July, 1849).
